Project Description/Justification:

The Road Weather Information System (RWIS) is a network of over 60 ESS strategically located along major roadways in Alaska. Each station has sensors that collect atmospheric data, pavement temperature and condition, sub-surface pavement temperatures, and visual images. The RWIS provides information to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) for Maintenance and Operations winter weather maintenance decisions such as snow plowing and deicing activities, for DOT&PF seasonal weight restriction decisions, and for safe and efficient travel. RWIS data are available on the DOT&PF road weather web site (http://roadweather.alaska.gov) and the 511 Travel in the Know web site (http://511.alaska.gov). RWIS data are shared with the National Weather Service for forecasts and the military.

Funding will be used to install new, upgrade and maintain the current network of sites, i.e., upgrade cameras to collect night time images, non-intrusive pavement temperature and condition sensors, and

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state-of-the-science sensors.
