## **Project Description/Justification:**

A new TIP for federal fiscal years 2015 – 2018 has recently been approved and incorporated into the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The program amount for AMATS in FY2016 is \$32 million.

With a relatively small program, priority shifts are very dependent on the project development process and the critical path for each project, whether it be right-of-way acquisition or cooperation with the utilities. In light of this fact, a single allocation of legislative authorization for AMATS' projects is requested.
