Project Description/Justification:

This project is anticipated to provide support for the following projects on the Northern Region portion of the Parks Highway:

Parks Highway - Milepost 183 to 192 Reconstruction

This project will reconstruct the Parks Highway between MP 183 and 192 and replace the East Fork Chulitna River Bridget #0260.

Parks Highway - Bridge Deck Rehabilitation

This project will rehabilitate the bridge decks of four bridges on the Parks Highway. Bridge #216 Nenana River at Rex, Bridge #202 Tanana River, Bridge #201 North Slough Tanana River, and Bridge #678 Little Goldstream Creek. Currently each bridge has a deck rating of poor or fair. The surface on each bridge is deteriorating rapidly, with rebar exposed. This project is necessary to eliminate hazards to motorists posed by this exposed steel.

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Parks Highway - Milepost 163 to 174 Rehabilitation

This project will rehabilitate the Parks Highway between MP 163 and 174, excluding the railroad crossing at MP 169.
