## **Project Description/Justification:**

The state Rural Airport System maintains approximately 20 Certificated Airports that must comply with Federal Aviation Regulations Part 139 as well as Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations. These airports are inspected annually by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and TSA to ensure the airports are in compliance with all federal regulations under their enforcement authority. Maintenance of appropriate access security to the restricted portion of the airport is a key requirement of the FAA and the TSA. Both of these federal agencies have the authority to impose significant fines and other measures against the department, if the airports are not in compliance with the federal security requirements.
