Prior Funding History / Additional Information:

No prior funding history.

Project Description/Justification:

Bethel Airport is one of the busiest in Alaska, and serves as the hub for over 35 villages in the surrounding area. Reconstruct the North Apron which has a very poor Pavement Condition Index of 23 and has had no major construction since 1985. Since the consolidation of several air carrier operations at the far north end of the airport, the north ramp has become the busiest area of the airport. The north ramp access road is now very congested and too narrow for passenger pick-up and drop off, medical transport, cargo delivery vehicles, pedestrians, and parking. Also construct a new connector road between Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway and the North Air Taxi Road.

Future maintenance and operating costs are estimated to increase by \$6,000 per year beginning in 2019.
