

Between FY15 FnlBud and FY25 Enacted:

- **UGF** increased by \$4 million (0.6%)
- **DGF** decreased by \$1.4 million (-76.1%)
- **Other funds** increased by \$11 million (157.6%)
- **Federal funds** increased by \$1,119.7 million (115.9%)

COVID-19: Congress approved an additional 6.2% to the Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage (FMAP) during COVID which has resulted in UGF savings to the State of \$59.1 million in FY20 and \$87.6 million in FY21; UGF was fully expended in FY22. Enhanced FMAP was stepped down over multiple quarters across state fiscal years 2023 and 2024.
