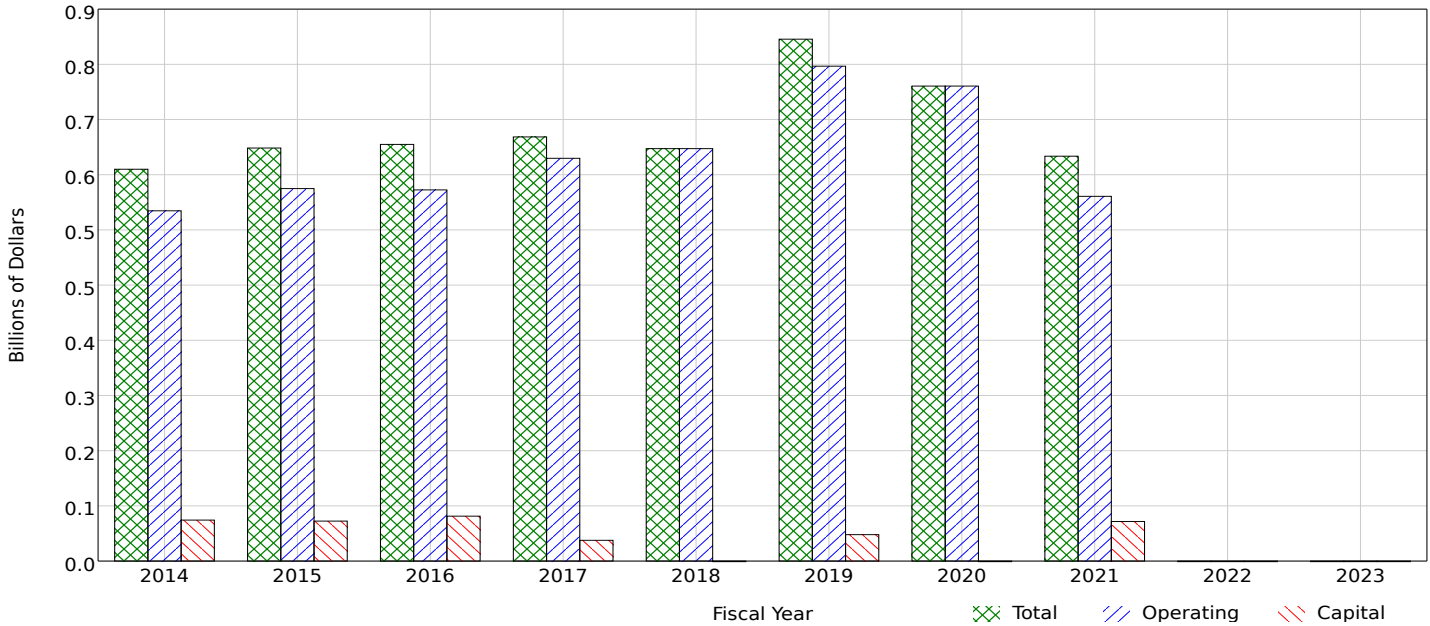

Source of Revenue

Same as general fund--all taxes, royalties, fees and interest earnings of the state, unless otherwise specified.

Restrictions on Use

Use of general fund match revenue is unrestricted.

Description and History

General fund match is a tracking code that identifies state funding required to secure other funding. Typically, general fund match secures federal funding for congressional projects or activities that require state financial participation.

General fund match is an unrestricted fund source, meaning that matching funds can be used for purposes other than securing federal or other funds. However, the intent of the fund code is to allow accurate tracking of matching fund requirements. Accuracy will not be achieved unless and until this code is used for all match and "maintenance of effort" requirements.

In order to improve tracking of match requirements, agencies are allowed (beginning in FY07) to exchange Unrestricted GF and GFM freely at any time during the budget process, including reporting actual expenditures.
