The Department's GF budget grew by \$6 million between FY08 and FY18 Governor's request -- an average annual growth rate of 4.6%.

The total percent of GF Growth from FY08 to FY18 Governor's request is 56.7%.

The department's total FY18 Governor's request GF budget equals \$50 per resident worker.\*

The Alaska Aerospace Corporation received the following general fund appropriations for on-going maintenance and operation costs:

FY12 -- \$4 million UGF (one-time funding)

FY13 -- \$8 million UGF (one-time funding)

FY14 -- \$8.1 million UGF (on-going) FY15 -- \$6.1 million UGF (one-time fundina)

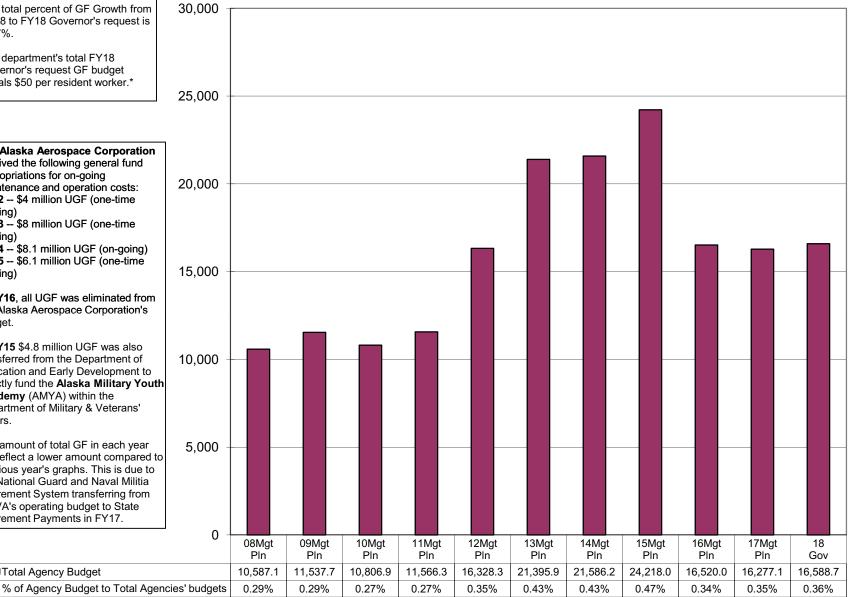
In FY16, all UGF was eliminated from the Alaska Aerospace Corporation's budget.

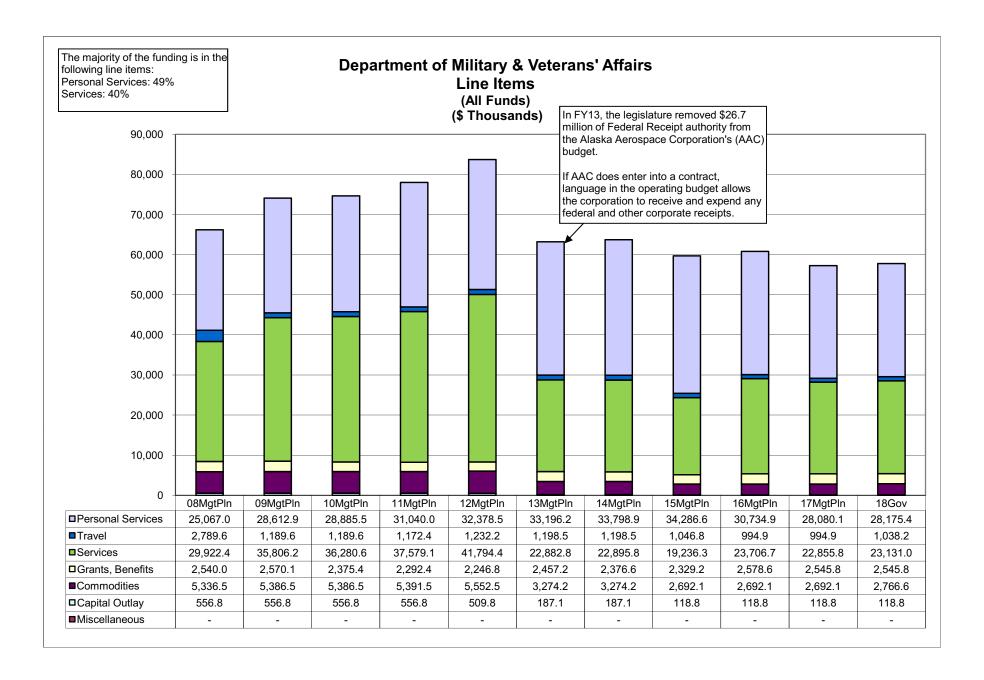

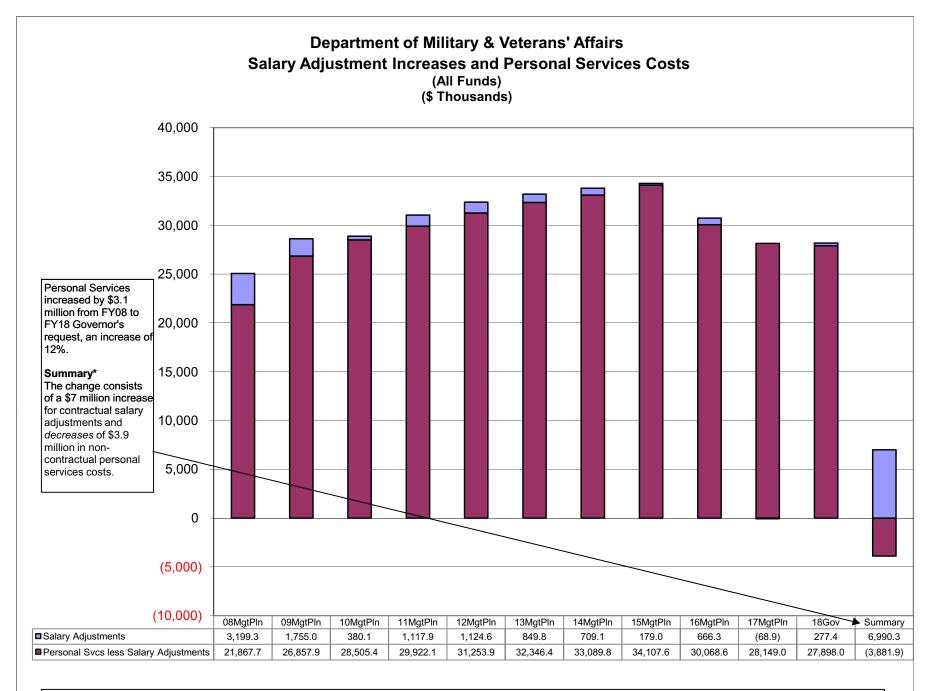

### **Department of Military & Veterans' Affairs Share of Total Agency Operations** (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)

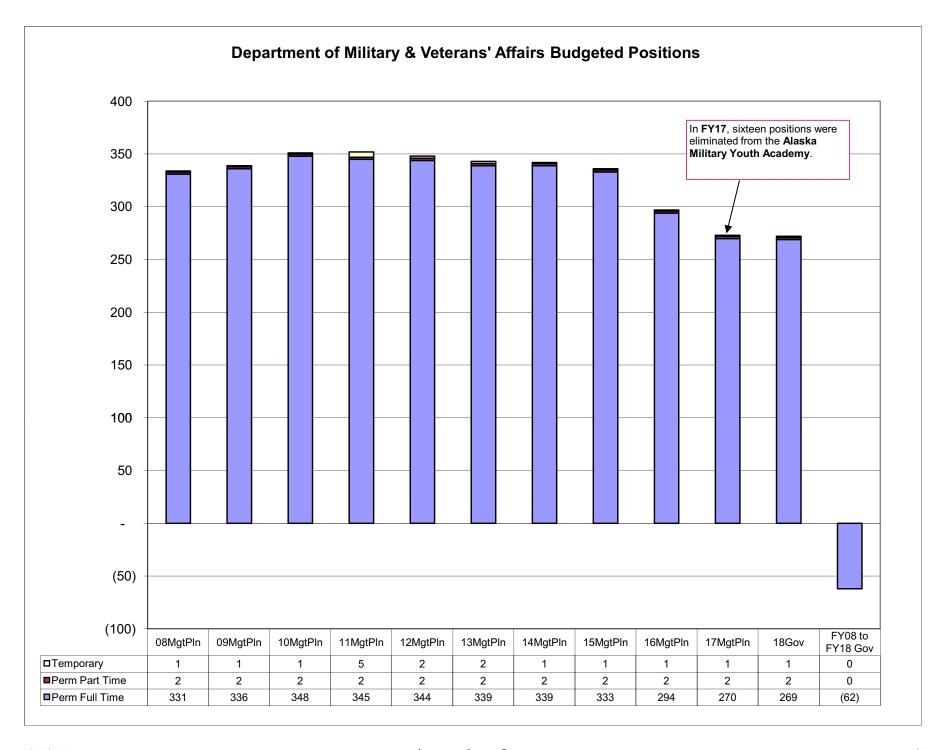

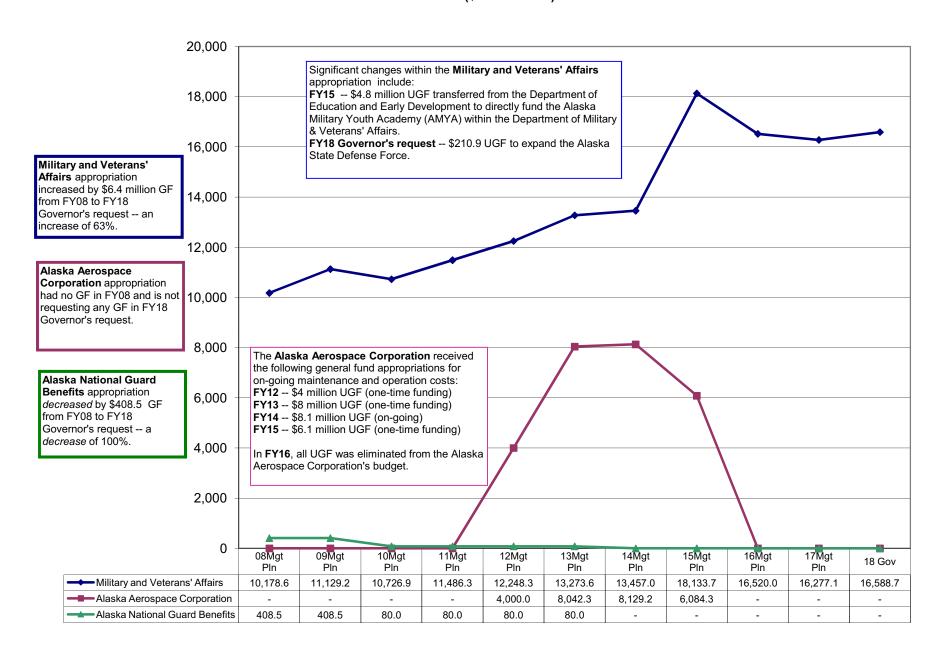




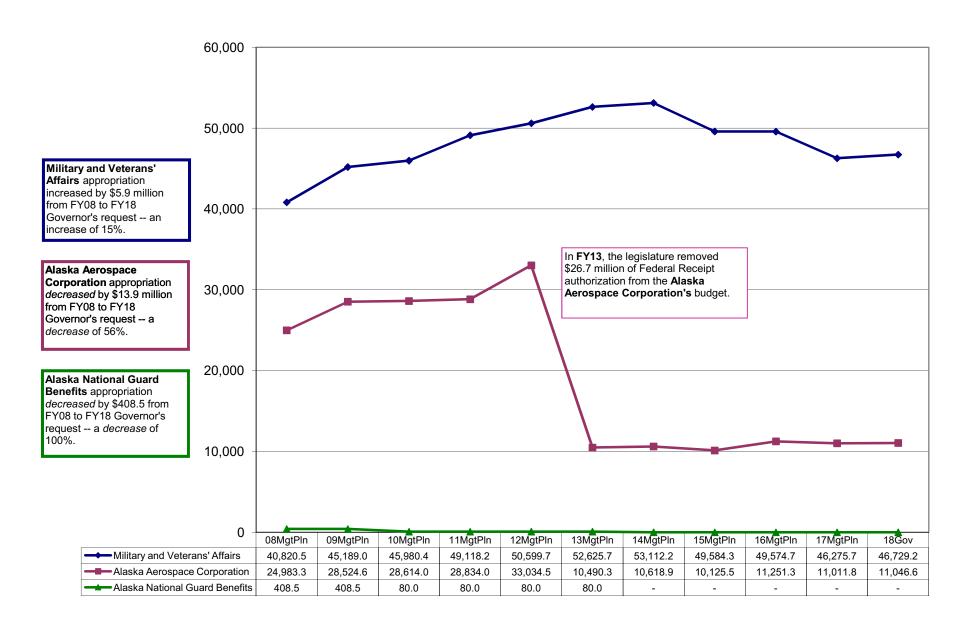

# Department of Military & Veterans' Affairs Total Funding Comparison by Fund Group (All Funds) (\$ Thousands)

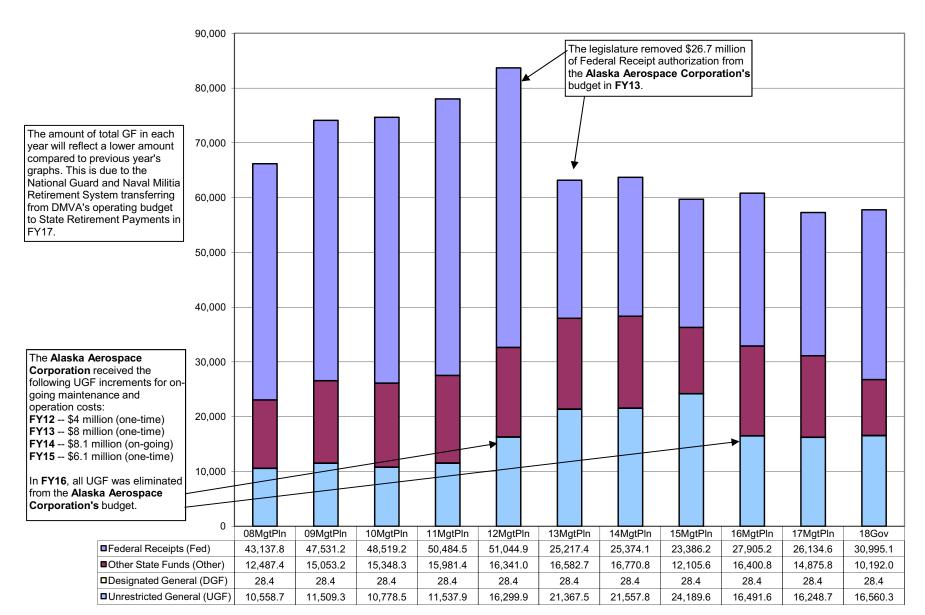
