GovSupp 12/15 (Governor Supplemental 12/15) - FY18 Supplemental requests submitted by the Governor on December 15th. Additional supplemental requests are expected.

**19Adj Base (FY19 Adjusted Base)** - FY18 Management Plan less one-time items, plus FY19 adjustments for position counts, funding transfers, line item transfers, temporary increments (IncT) from prior years, and additions for statewide items (risk management and most salary and benefit increases). The Adjusted Base is the "first cut" of the FY19 budget; it is the base to which the Governor's and the Legislature's increments, decrements, and fund changes are added.

19GovAdj (FY19 Governor w/LFD Adjust) - FY19 Governor's Request with LFD Adjustments for proposed legislation and budget actions that require a supermajority vote.
